Commencing 24th June 2020 until further notice¹:

Monday to Friday	Visiting Hours	11.00am - 5.30pm
Saturday/Sunday	Visiting Hours	11.00am - 3.00pm

Length of Visits	Visitors can stay during published visiting hours
Number of Visitors	Maximum of 2 visitors at one time
Children	Children must be strictly supervised (flu vaccination applies)
Location	In room visits only, with access to outdoor area

Precautions

- ✓ Hand sanitiser on arrival and before touching surfaces
- ✓ Completion of screening questions on entry
- ✓ Temperature reading must be below 37.5 degrees
- ✓ Evidence of flu vaccination e.g. medical certificate or Medicare printout
- ✓ No access to common areas such as the resident lounge or dining rooms
- ✓ Strict physical distancing – remain 1.5 m apart with no physical contact
- ✓ Try to limit your community exposure to the virus prior to visiting

We also recommend you download the COVIDSafe App, though this is not mandatory

Entry is not permitted if a visitor:

- ✗ Is unwell, has a fever or symptoms of respiratory illness (eg cough, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath) or other infectious illness
- ✗ Has been diagnosed with COVID-19 (until medical certification of full recovery)
- ✗ Has been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19
- ✗ Has been in close contact with or caring for someone who is currently unwell
- ✗ Has returned from overseas or a cruise in the last 14 days
- ✗ Cannot provide evidence of current flu vaccination
- ✗ Resides or works in a current hotspot

Resident Outings – Public Health Order Dated 23rd June 2020

- ✓ Residents can attend small family gatherings following a risk assessment by the staff. 48 hours notice is appreciated
- ✓ Details regarding the visit location, number of people and date of visit must be provided to reception
- ✗ External group excursions are not permitted
