



YALLAMBEE VILLAGE COVID SAFE PLAN

- ✓ Safety signage is displayed at the Village entry & Community Centre
- ✓ All residents, staff, volunteers and visitors to the Community Centre must complete the screening process and have their temperature taken prior to admission. Persons who are unwell are not permitted to enter
- ✓ Hand sanitiser is provided and must be used by all visitors to the Community Centre.
- ✓ Staff have received training on COVID-19 and receive regular updates from management regarding WHS protocols (i.e. handwashing and infection control training.) Staff are aware that must be tested and remain off work until cleared if they are displaying flu like symptoms.
- ✓ 1.5m distance must be adhered to for all residents, staff and visitors.
- ✓ Bookings are essential for all activities.
- ✓ Room capacity signs are displayed and numbers must be adhered to.
- ✓ Activities requiring shared equipment will not proceed at this time
- ✓ Microfibre cleaning system is in place to assist with extra cleaning of equipment and shared surfaces.
- ✓ Name & contact details of all visitors will be kept for contact tracing for 28 days.

Café

- ✓ Bookings are encouraged to manage numbers in the café (4 inside, 6 outside)
- ✓ Tables have been removed to allow for social distancing.
- ✓ No share plates, communal snacks or buffet is to be served.
- ✓ Laminated menus will be provided with daily specials on the blackboard.
- ✓ Contactless payment is encouraged.

Library

- ✓ Bookings are essential and numbers are limited
- ✓ Gloves are provided at the entry and must be worn in the library
- ✓ Returned books will be quarantined for 48 hours prior to placement on the shelves
