

Dear Residents, Families and Friends,

I am pleased to report that we remain free of COVID-19 at Evergreen Life Care, however, community transmission of COVID-19 is continuing in NSW – especially in South Western and other areas of Sydney.

Continued Pause on Visiting

For this reason, the NSW Department Health this afternoon advised that the pause on visiting must remain in place **for the next 7 days**. This temporary requirement will be reviewed next week by the Department and Evergreen will provide an update as soon as possible.

Exceptions can only be made on compassionate grounds in circumstances such as end of life care by application to the facility manager or care manager.

Video Calling

Our team are very happy to facilitate a 'virtual visit' using video call technology. While we understand this is not the same as a face: face visit, it can be beneficial for both residents and families.

Video calls can be booked between Monday – Friday 11.00am – 5.30pm and Saturday - Sunday 11.00am – 3.00pm. Assistance can be provided to residents where needed.
