While Evergreen remains free of COVID-19 cases, low rates of community transmission continue in NSW with five (5) cases identified in the last week, one (1) of these where the source of infection is unknown.

Visitor Access Restrictions

Access to Yallambee Lodge is currently not permitted for visitors who have in the last 14 days been in any of the locations on:

- The [self-isolate and get tested immediately list](#) in Liverpool and Leppington at the times and dates listed
- The [monitor for symptoms list](#), in Liverpool at the times and dates listed except where noted otherwise on the webpage
- In Victoria (apart from the Victorian border region).

You may visit if you have been in [areas with increased testing](#) (Camden, Liverpool, Wingecarribee), but will need to be escorted to and from the resident room.

We ask that you continue to monitor these lists for the latest updates.
