Length of Visits	Not limited for close family and friends within visiting hours
Number of Visitors	Maximum- 2 visitors at once
Children	Children must be strictly supervised (flu vaccination applies)
Location	Visitors are encouraged to remain in resident rooms or outdoor areas Video calls, phone calls and window visits can also be arranged as an alternative

Conditions of Entry

- ✓ Wearing of facemasks is requested for visitors (exemptions apply, please see Management)
- ✓ Hand sanitiser on arrival and before touching surfaces
- ✓ Completion of screening questions on entry
- ✓ Temperature reading must be below 37.5 degrees
- ✓ Evidence of flu vaccination e.g. medical certificate or Medicare printout
- ✓ Strict physical distancing – remain 1.5 m apart unless providing care
- ✓ Try to limit your community exposure to the virus prior to visiting.

Entry is not permitted for staff or visitors who:

- ✗ Have been diagnosed with COVID-19 (until medical certification of full recovery)
- ✗ Have a fever (37.5°C or higher) or any other symptoms consistent with COVID-19. This includes cough, headache, fatigue, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, and loss of taste or loss of smell, muscle pain, joint pain, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting and loss of appetite.
- ✗ Have in the last 14 days been identified as a close contact of a COVID-19 case
- ✗ Have in the last 14 days been in any of the locations listed on the self-isolate and get tested immediately list, at the times and dates listed.
- ✗ Have in the last 14 days been in any of the locations listed on the monitor for symptoms page, at the times and dates listed.
- ✗ have in the last 14 days been in a location of interest in New Zealand
- ✗ On or after 7 November 2020 have been in a contact tracing location in South Australia.
- ✗ Victorian residents can visit residential aged care facilities in NSW from 23 November 2020.
- ✗ Use extra precaution for visitors and staff who have been in areas with increased testing (Liverpool LGA and Wingecarribee LGA)

Resident Outings

- ✓ Medical and essential appointments are permitted
- ✓ Excursions and small gatherings are permitted where the group is known, and appropriate infection prevention and control measures are in place
- ✓ A Risk Assessment must be completed prior to leaving the facility
 - As a guide, small gatherings in the family home, a walk, a drive or visit to Everbean Café or Gosford RSL Club are deemed lower risk outings at this time
 - While ever there is no community transmission, other venues may also be suitable
- ✓ Residents and companions are asked to wear a mask at all times if unable to maintain 1.5 m social distance.
